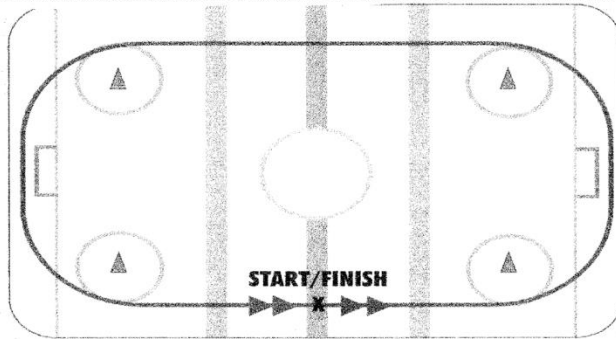

TIME OF COMPETITION:

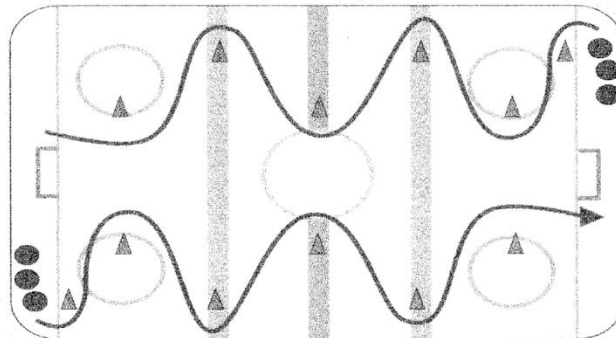

NOTE: Players should come dressed in equipment, as dressing room space is limited.



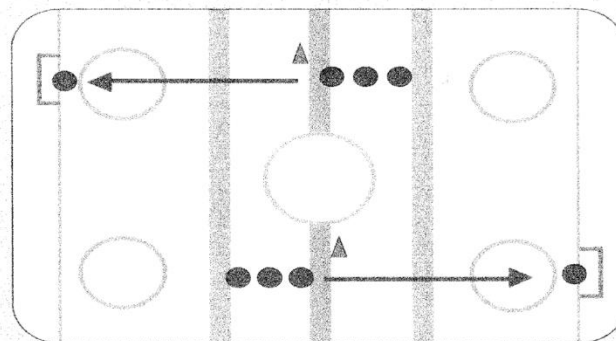
RACE

- Each player is timed through course.
- If a pylon is knocked down, a two second penalty will be assessed.
- Best time wins.
- Two players per team eligible. Players cannot participate in any other event.



STICK HANDLING SKILL

- Each player carries puck through pylon course.
- From Goal line to Goal line is timed.
- If a pylon knocked down, a two second penalty will be assessed.
- Best time wins.
- Two players per team eligible. Players cannot participate in any other event.



SHOOTOUT

Two skaters and a goalie from the same team must participate (total of 3 players)
 Format same as NHL with each skater shooting on opponent's goal.
 Team with most points after both shooters advances.
 If tied players alternate shots in a sudden life format
